What is Xtreme Life?

Xtreme Life is a weekend camp designed with the foster teen in mind. The camping experience is geared for success, recognizing the needs of abused, neglected and abandoned youth.

Each teen is paired with an adult counselor (there's a strict ratio of one adult counselor to every 2 campers). All counselors and staff are volunteers who have been carefully screened and trained to work with children in state care, so you can be assured your child is in good hands.

At camp, your child will receive lots of individual attention in a wholesome environment, participating in a variety of fun and educational activities such as:

- Low and high ropes
 Break-out sessions
 - Team games
- Chapel
- Art activities
- Football

The attention of caring adults, building friendships with other teens in the "system" and the thrill of successfully completing projects and sports results in a host of positive memories and enhanced selfesteem.



A weekend of positive memories

As a foster parent, you're the real hero: providing an abandoned or abused child with a safe home and security. But you may need a break. And your foster child's life and outlook can be enhanced by happy memories which can aid in the healing of the scars of abuse and provide a foundation for future happiness.
